

## Temporary Permit Special Act Information

The **TEMPORARY PERMIT [ABT-6003](#)** this license category allows a bona-fide non-profit civic organization, charitable organization, municipality or county to sell alcoholic beverages for consumption on premises for a period not to exceed 3 days for a single event. Beginning July 1, 2016, these organizations are limited to 12 permits per calendar year with the exception of small areas within Bay, Indian River, Lake, Leon, Marion, and Pinellas Counties which are allowed to have an additional 15 permits per calendar year.

**HB-1407 City of St. Petersburg, Pinellas County\***: Authorizes Division of Alcoholic Beverages & Tobacco of DBPR to issue temporary permits to nonprofit civic organizations for sale of alcohol for consumption on premises at outdoor events on public right-of-way in downtown St. Petersburg, subject to statutory requirements. For purposes of this act, the downtown area of St. Petersburg is that area between 5th Avenues North and South and between 16th Street and the waterfront.

**HB-1411 Hillsborough County:**

Authorizes issuance of alcoholic beverage license to Tampa Bay History Center, Inc.; provides for use of license for special events only; provides for removal from premises of open containers; provides for transfer of license under certain circumstances.

**HB-1445- City of Tallahassee, Leon County\*:**

Authorizes Division of Alcoholic Beverages & Tobacco of DBPR to issue temporary permits to nonprofit civic organizations for sale of alcohol for consumption on premises at outdoor events on public right-of-way in downtown Tallahassee, subject to statutory requirements. For purposes of this act, the downtown area of Tallahassee is that area beginning at the intersection of Wahnish Way and West Orange Avenue, running north along Wahnish Way, Railroad Avenue, and Macomb Street to West Park Avenue, then east to North Meridian Street, then south to Apalachee Parkway, then east to Suwannee Street, then south to Myers Park Drive, then east to Golf Terrace Drive, then south to East Magnolia Drive, then west to South Meridian Street, then south to East Orange Avenue, then west to the point of beginning at the intersection of Wahnish Way and West Orange Avenue, the total area encompassing approximately 1.5 square miles. **Effective Date:** June 17, 2008

## 2009

**HB 1169 - City of Leesburg, Lake County\*:** Authorizes Division of Alcoholic Beverages & Tobacco of DBPR to issue temporary permits to nonprofit civic organizations for sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption on premises at outdoor events on public right-of-way in City of Leesburg, subject to statutory & other specified requirements; requires division to adopt rules. For purposes of this act, the downtown area of Leesburg is that area bounded by North Boulevard on the north, Lake Street on the east, Dixie Avenue on the south, and 12th Street and Perkins Street on the west.

**HB-1049- City of Eustis, Lake County\*:** Authorizes Division of Alcoholic Beverages & Tobacco of DBPR to issue temporary permits to nonprofit civic organization for sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption on premises at outdoor events on public right-of-way in downtown Eustis, subject to certain statutory requirements; provides that such events require street-closure permit from city; provides that permits authorized by act are in addition to certain other authorized temporary permits.

### **CS/CS/HB 1367 City of Vero Beach, Indian River County\***

CS/CS/HB1367, City of Vero Beach, Indian River County, was approved by the Governor on May 12, 2014. The bill allows the Division of Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco to issue up to 12 temporary permits per calendar year to a bona fide nonprofit civic organization for sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises at outdoor events in the Vero Beach Downtown Area. These permits are in addition to the 3 temporary permits per calendar year currently allowed by law.

### **CS/CS/HB 1443 City of Ocala, Marion County\***

CS/CS/HB1443, City of Ocala, Marion County, was approved by the Governor on May 12, 2014. The bill allows the Division of Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco to issue up to 15 temporary permits per calendar year to a bona fide nonprofit civic organization for sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises at outdoor events in the Ocala Downtown Area. These permits are in addition to the 3 temporary permits per calendar year currently allowed by law.

### **CS/HB 911 City of Panama City, Bay County\***

CS/HB911, City of Panama City, Bay County, was approved by the Governor on May 12, 2014. The bill authorizes the Division of Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco to give up to 15 special allowances per calendar year to bona fide consumption on the premises licensees for sale of alcoholic beverages in open containers to be removed from the premises by patrons at outdoor events in two Panama City areas designated as entertainment districts. These permits are in addition to any other temporary permits per calendar year currently allowed by law.

## 2015

### **HB 1337 - Pinellas County/Alcoholic Beverage Temporary Permits**

Authorizes the Division of Alcoholic Beverages & Tobacco to issue up to 15 temporary permits per calendar year to a bona fide nonprofit civic organization, upon application and presentation of a valid special event permit issued by an incorporated municipality in Pinellas County. The temporary permit authorizes the sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises within a special event permitted area designated by the municipality. The temporary permits authorized by this act are in addition to the three temporary permits authorized per year for a nonprofit civic organization pursuant to s. 561.422, Florida Statutes

## 2016

**HB-709- City of Tallahassee, Leon County\*:** Authorizes Division of Alcoholic Beverages & Tobacco of DBPR to issue temporary permits to nonprofit civic organizations for sale of alcohol for consumption on premises at outdoor events on public right-of-way in downtown Tallahassee, subject to statutory requirements.

For purposes of this act, the downtown area of Tallahassee is that area beginning at the intersection of Wahnish Way and West Orange Avenue, running north along Wahnish Way to Okaloosa Street; then west on Okaloosa Street to Perry Street; then north on Perry Street to Gamble Street; then east on Gamble Street to Wahnish Way, Railroad Avenue, and Macomb Street to West Park Avenue; then east to North Meridian Street; then south to Apalachee Parkway; then east to Suwannee Street; then south to Myers Park Drive; then east to Golf Terrace Drive; then south to East Magnolia Drive, then west to South Meridian Street; then south to East Orange Avenue; then west to the point of beginning at the intersection of Wahnish Way and West Orange Avenue, the total area encompassing approximately 1.5 square miles.
