INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILING THE PETITION FOR APPOINTMENT OF AN ELECTION MONITOR

A completed petition, copy of the first notice of election, and qualified voter list of unit owners must be filed with this office no later than fourteen (14) days prior to the scheduled election.

- 1. At least fifteen percent (15%) or six (6), whichever number is greater, of the qualified voters affix their original signature, printed name, date, and unit number to the petition. Add additional second pages as needed. Qualified owners of more than one unit must sign separately for each unit.

- 3. If the petition is deficient, the unit owners' representative will be notified and afforded five (5) calendar days from receipt of the notice to correct all deficiencies.
- 4. Upon appointment of an election monitor, the association's registered agent and petitioners' representative will be notified.
- 5. Pursuant to Florida law, the association is responsible to pay all fees and costs incurred by the election monitor.
