

The following is a list of accredited architecture schools and first professional programs according to NAAB publications from 1945 to the present.

Prior to 1974, accreditation status was given to an entire university. This procedure was revised through the Restructuring Study of 1974 to require accreditation of a university's individual degree programs. This list includes professional degree programs of those schools accredited prior to 1974.

NAAB carefully reviewed the lists from 1945 to 1974 to eliminate non-accredited first professional degrees and to include programs which were phasing out, but had not yet graduated their last students.

Prior to 1974, some programs were listed without clarification of their status. Since the Restructuring Study of 1974, this list reflects the current accrediting practice.

- Continuing programs are shown by the first academic year of listing, followed by a dash (i.e., <u>B. Arch. 1945/46</u>-)
- Phased out programs with no NAAB action to terminate accreditation are shown by the year of the first and last lists on which the program would have appeared under current accreditation procedures, followed by a period (i.e., <u>B. Arch. 1945/46–1952/53.</u>)

Programs for which NAAB terminated accreditation are shown by the year of the first and last lists on which the program appeared, followed by an "x" (i.e., B. Arch. 1945/46–1952/53x)

Since procedures have changed over the past 35 years, it is possible that when a program was in a phase-out process, some persons may have graduated with a first professional degree after the last listed year. If a first professional degree is not identified as accredited or terminated, consult NAAB so that a search of the records can confirm the program's status, and if appropriate, this list will be revised.

NCARB considers that students who graduated either during the years listed, or two years prior to the years listed, hold an accredited degree. The academic year of programs accredited prior to 1980/81 begins July 1 and those programs accredited during 1980/81 and after, are effective as of January 1. For example, a program accredited on January 1, 1984, would be listed 1983/84— and would graduate its first class in the spring of 1984. NCARB recommends that all graduates in or after the spring of 1982 should be considered to hold an accredited degree.

Beginning in 1985, the NAAB accrediting cycle was changed to a calendar year basis. For example, programs accredited on January-1, 1985 (and thereafter) would be listed 1985— and graduate its first class in the spring of 1985. In this case a graduate in or after the spring of 1983 should be considered to hold an accredited degree.
