- The board approved the licensure ratification list with the exception of one architectural certificate of authorization which was pulled from the list by Ms. Chastain.
- The board discussed a letter from Raul Rodriguez, Chairman of the Florida Building Commission, requesting continuing education hours be granted for licensees who serve on the Commission. The board asked that the letter be included in the agenda when they discuss amending the continuing education rule at the October meeting.
- The board discussed an e-mail from Ms. Jane Grosslight regarding continuing education providers and the board asked that the letter be included in the agenda when they discuss amending the continuing education rule at the October meeting.
- The board discussed a letter from Mr. Scot Di Stefano regarding disciplinary actions remaining on the internet indefinitely. Mr. Minacci and Ms. Chastain commented they have talked with Mr. Di Stefano and informed him the board feels the information should remain on the system.
- The board reviewed a letter from the North Carolina Board of Architecture that went to all Florida residents holding North Carolina licenses informing them that North Carolina will no longer reciprocate with Florida for continuing education. They must now meet the continuing education requirements of North Carolina.
- The board reviewed the Executive Summary submitted by Jeff Huberman, Region 3 Director.
