

Asbestos Business (ZA-5903) Delinquent License Renewal Information

(A \$5 ULA fee waiver and a 50% renewal fee reduction is in effect this renewal period)

Every day we work to improve the way we do business in order to serve you better. **If you are renewing in an active status, a copy of your license will be sent to the email address associated with your online account once you renew your license.** This process significantly reduces the amount of time it would have otherwise taken for you to receive your license in the mail. The Department will no longer print and mail initial, renewed or duplicate licenses.

If you wish to print your active status license at any time in the future you may do so using your secure online account with the Department. Please log into www.MyFloridaLicense.com to access your account and follow the step by step instructions on how to **print your license**. Additionally, after you have created an online account and linked your license you may view a copy of your professional license on your mobile device using the DBPR mobile application. You may download the DBPR mobile application from the Apple App Store or Google Play. Once you have installed the application select "My License" and enter the same login and password information that you used to create your online account to view a copy of your professional license.

Fee information:

- If postmarked or submitted electronically by midnight ET, November 30, 2023 the fee is \$400.
- Submissions after November 30, 2023 ET will not be accepted. The license will become null and void on December 1, 2023.

Important information

- Businesses cannot be inactive.
- If you no longer wish to have an active business license, visit www.MyFloridaLicense.com > Apply or Manage My License > and follow the links to your professional group's information and follow those instructions. It is not necessary to return this renewal notice if the business is closed.
- State law requires you to maintain a current email and mailing address with the Department of Business and Professional Regulation. All official correspondence from the Department will be sent to the email or mailing address of record including license renewal notices, important board information, service of process, etc.

- It is strongly recommended that you keep your telephone number current with the Department.
- If you have a compliance order with a past due payment your license will not be renewed until it has been made current.
