II. Major Issues/Actions

- The board approved two licensure applications and denied 28 licensure applications.
- The board approved four continuing education course applications.
- Mr. Dustin Metz, Assistant General Counsel, provided a report that indicated that as of January 6, 2012, there were 24 private and 16 public barber cases in the legal section.
- Ms. Robyn Barineau, Executive Director, reported that the board's operating account balance at September 30, 2011, was over \$740,000, and the unlicensed activity account balance for the same period was over \$288,000. She added that the Department projects that these two accounts will maintain a positive cash balance at least through June 30, 2016.
- Ms. Rachel Clark, Assistant Attorney General, informed the board that the rules that were previously repealed by the board were withdrawn and refiled. She added that some concerns were raised by the Joint Administrative Procedures Committee which have been addressed. She will keep the board apprised of the progress of the refiled rules.
