II. Major Issues/Actions

- Ms. Erica White, Chief Attorney, introduced Ms. Danyiela Janjic, Assistant General Counsel, who will assist with Florida Barbers' Board disciplinary cases.
- The board considered 109 disciplinary cases.
- Ms. White informed the board that as of October 30, 2013, there were 385 barbering cases in the Office of General Counsel.
- The board approved 14 licensure applications and denied six licensure applications.
- The board expanded their Criminal History Guidelines List.
- Ms. Rachel Clark, Assistant Attorney General, mentioned the board rules currently in progress for repeal or amendment.
Ms. Robyn Barineau, Executive Director, reported that the balance in the board's operation and unlicensed activity accounts as of the end of the fiscal year, June 30, 2013, was over \$1.310 million and over \$289k, respectively. She added that the Department projects the board to maintain a positive cash balance in their accounts through at least June 30, 2018.
