HEARING AND PETITIONS

BEERMAN, LUKE A – REQUEST FOR INFORMAL HEARING

Mr. Beerman was present.

Mr. Barnhart presented this case stating Mr. Beerman's application for a Certified General Contractor's license was denied at the November 2019 meeting of the Board for failure to demonstrate the required experience, pursuant to section 489.111, Florida Statutes, and Rule 61G4-15.001, Florida Administrative Code. The Notice of Intent to Deny was filed in December of 2019. Mr. Beerman timely requested an informal hearing.

After discussion, the Board voted to vacate the previous denial and to approve the application as a downgrade to a Certified Building Contractor.

Mr. Barnhart presented this case stating Mr. Blanco filed a petition for a Declaratory Statement on December 12, 2019. The petition was noticed in the Florida Administrative Register on January 21, 2020. Mr. Barnhart noted the petitioner asked whether a contractor possessing a certificate of competency issued by the Department of Business and Professional Regulation is exempt from ordinances adopted by the commissioners of a county.

After discussion, the Board voted to deny the petition.

Mr. Barnhart presented this case stating Mr. Harris filed a petition for variance and waiver on December 17, 2019. The petition was noticed in the Florida Administrative Register on January 17, 2020. Mr. Barnhart noted the petitioner does not cite a rule, but appears to be asking the Board for a variance of Rule 61G4-16.009, and to extend the deadline by which an applicant must pass all portions of the licensing examination.

After discussion, the Board voted to deny the petition, finding that the petitioner did not establish that the purpose of the underlying statute has been or will be met if the petitioner was granted a variance or waiver, and finding that the petitioner failed to establish that the Board's application of the rule to petitioner's circumstances would violate the principles of fairness or impose a substantial hardship.

KEARNS, CHARLES – PETITION FOR DECLARATORY STATEMENT

Mr. Kearns had counsel present.

Mr. Barnhart presented this case stating Mr. Kearns filed a petition for a Declaratory Statement on March 20, 2019. The petition was noticed in the Florida Administrative Register on March 22, 2019. Mr. Barnhart noted the petitioner asks whether a license issued by the Department of Business and Professional Regulation is required to construction an artificial reef.

After discussion, the Board voted to continue the petition for 30 days.

LE, AMYLOU – REQUEST FOR INFORMAL HEARING

Mr. Barnhart presented this case stating Ms. Le's application for a change of status for her Certified Air Conditioning Contractor's license was denied at the June 2019 meeting of the Board for: failing to provide a social security number for all authorized representatives of the business; because the applicant had prior discipline which she failed to disclose on the application; and for failure to provide an acceptable credit report, pursuant to Section 489.115, Florida Statutes and Rule 61G4-15.006, Florida Administrative Code. The Notice of Intent to Deny was filed in July of 2019. Ms. Le timely requested an informal hearing.

After discussion, the Board voted to vacate the previous denial and to approve the application.

A motion was made and passed to remove the word “or aggravating” from Rule 61-G4-17.002 Aggravating and Mitigating Circumstances. The rest of the language was accepted. The Board voted that no SERC would be required, that violation of the rule should not be considered a minor violation and result in a Notice of Non-Compliance, and that new “sunset date” provision not be added to the rule language.

Discussion also took place, with the Florida Nursery Growers and Landscapers Association about the revisions of Rule 61-G4-15.035 Certification of Irrigation Specialty Contractors. The Board indicated that more discussion on the language would take place at a future meeting.
