EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR’S REPORT – Daniel Biggins

CHAIRMAN’S REPORT –Keith Lawson

Mr. Lawson requested that the Board be kept up to date on legislative bills as they become available.

PROSECUTING ATTORNEY’S REPORT – Ian Brown

Mr. Brown gave the following report:

For the month of January 2019, the overall license activity case load was 1520, up from 1390 in December of 2018, and up from 822 in January 2018.

There were 869 cases currently in Legal to be reviewed, 310 cases awaiting PC Panel/ Initial Review Completed, 22 cases set for probable cause, 56 cases where probable cause had been found/administrative complaints filed, 0 settlement stipulation approved, 24 informal hearings requested, 0 cases awaiting outside action, 37 cases ready for default, 105 formal hearings requested, 1 cases referred to DOAH, 5 cases in settlement negotiations, 0 case pending board date, 81 cases set for board presentation, 0 cases awaiting final orders, 0 cases under appeal and 0 cases had been re-opened.

For the month of January 2019, 74 cases were closed.

Mr. Brown informed the board that the Office of General Counsel is in dire need of volunteers from the board to assist in probable cause. His office may end up going to two probable cause meetings a month to keep with the volume of complaints that are flowing into the Department.

Mr. Barnhart presented this case stating Mr. Wilson's application for a Registered General Contractor's license was denied at the December 2018 meeting of the Board. for failure to demonstrate financial stability and responsibility, pursuant to section 489.115, Florida Statutes and Rule 61G4-15.006, Florida Administrative Code. The Notice of Intent to Deny was filed in January of 2019. Mr. Wilson timely requested board reconsideration.

After discussion, the board voted to grant a 180 day continuance with rights to DOAH.
