**GENERAL SESSION**

The meeting was called to order by Rick Kane, at 9:00am. Ms. Wood gave the Invocation. Mr. Maphis led the Pledge of Allegiance.

**EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR’S REPORT – Daniel Biggins**

Mr. Biggins requested the Board excuse absences for the absent board members:

- Mr. Thomason
- Mr. Cobb
- Mr. Feaster

- Mr. Donovan

Mr. Biggins informed the board they will be receiving an email regarding CJIS training and to please complete the training at their earliest opportunity.

Mr. Biggins mentioned that the Board's concerns over the exam length being shortened were taken into consideration and that the Department was able to find a way to keep the time limits the same. Mr. Biggins also mentioned that NASCLA representatives would be appearing in front of the Board at the May meeting to provide information and answer any questions.

Mr. Biggins also recognized Ms. Ramsey Revell for her service to the Board.

With nothing further to report the board voted unanimously to approve this report.

#### **CHAIRMAN'S REPORT – Rick Kane**

Mr. Kane discussed military endorsement applications and reminded the Board Members, by way of the Board Member Handbook, that they are required to ensure that they are not placing any "unfair requirements" on applicant seeking licensure. Mr. Kane asked Board Members to be cognizant of that fact when evaluating applications.

With nothing further to report the board voted unanimously to approve this report.

#### **PROSECUTING ATTORNEY'S REPORT – Ian Brown**

Mr. Brown gave the following report:

For the month of February 2018, the overall license activity case load was 910, up from 822 in January of 2018, and down from 971 in February 2017.

There were 466 cases currently in Legal to be reviewed, 203 cases awaiting PC Panel/ Initial Review Completed, 2 cases set for probable cause, 68 cases where probable cause had been found/administrative complaints filed, 1 settlement stipulation approved, 3 informal hearings requested, 0 cases awaiting outside action, 26 cases ready for default, 80 formal hearings requested, 0 case referred to DOAH, 7 cases in settlement negotiations, 0 case pending board date, 51 cases set for board presentation, 3 cases awaiting final orders, 0 cases under appeal and 0 cases had been re-opened.

For the month of February 2018, 123 cases were closed; this included 12 Final Orders with Discipline.

Mr. Brown also recognized Ms. Ramsey Revell for her service to the Board.

#### **ATTORNEY GENERAL'S REPORT – Rachel Clark**

#### **ARGUELLES, J. ALEJANDRO – REQUEST FOR INFORMAL HEARING**

The Notice of Intent to Deny was filed in February of 2018. Mr. Engebretson timely requested board reconsideration.

After discussion, the board voted to vacate the previous denial and allow the applicant to withdraw his application.

#### **ENGLETT, PHILIP – REQUEST FOR INFORMAL HEARING**

Mr. Englett was present.

Ms. Clark presented this case stating Mr. Englett's application to qualify IDN Development & Construction, LLC, as an additional business entity, was denied at the September 2017 meeting of the Board for failure to demonstrate the qualifying agent would have the ability to supervise the construction work and business activities of the organization, as required by section 489.119, Florida Statutes and Rule 61G4-15.0024, Florida Administrative Code. The Notice of Intent to Deny was filed in January of 2018. Mr. Englett timely requested board reconsideration.

After discussion, the board voted to vacate the previous denial and approve the application contingent on providing proof of 7 hours of live CE.

Ms. Clark presented this case stating Mr. Fernandez's application for a Certified Roofing Contractors' license was denied at the January 2018 meeting of the Board for failure to demonstrate the required experience, pursuant to section 489.111, F.S. and Rule 61G4-15.001, Florida Administrative Code. The Notice of Intent to Deny was filed in February of 2018. Mr. Fernandez timely requested board reconsideration.

After discussion, the board voted to uphold the denial.

### **HAFNER, STEPHEN – REQUEST FOR INFORMAL HEARING**

Mr. Hafner was present.

Ms. Clark presented this case stating Mr. Hafner's application for a Certified Building Contractor's license was denied at the October 2017 meeting of the Board for failure to demonstrate the required experience, pursuant to section 489.111, Florida Statutes, and Rule 61G4-15.001, Florida Administrative Code. Failure to sufficiently demonstrate financial stability and responsibility, pursuant to section 489.115, Florida Statutes and RULE 61G4-15.006, Florida Administrative Code. The Notice of Intent to Deny was filed in November of 2017. Mr. Hafner timely requested board reconsideration.

After discussion, the board voted to vacate the denial and approve the application for an Industrial Specialty license.
