GENERAL SESSION

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Lawson, at 9:03am. Mr. Boyette gave the Invocation. Mr. Lawson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

REVIEW OF MEETING MINUTES

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR’S REPORT – Daniel Biggins

Mr. Biggins requested the Board excuse absences for the following board members:

- Mr. Cathey
- Mr. Lawson

Mr. Biggins introduced Mario Famada, the recently appointed board member, who was appointed to sit in the previously vacant roofing contractor position.

Mr. Biggins introduced Mr. Norman from the Department of Education. Mr. Norman presented information to the Board regarding the Department of Education’s apprenticeship programs. Mr. Biggins thanked Mr. Norman and requested the Board open a rule for development that would allow applicants in apprenticeship programs to use their experience in said program to count towards meeting the requirements for licensure. Mr. Biggins presented a preliminary draft of proposed rule language. After discussion, the Board voted unanimously to open a rule for development. Mr. Biggins thanked the Board and suggested the Board’s counsel would work with the Department of Education to refine the rule language to suit their requirements and would present it to the Board at a future meeting.

With nothing further to report the board voted unanimously to approve this report.

CHAIRMAN’S REPORT –Keith Lawson

The Board Chair had nothing to report.

PROSECUTING ATTORNEY’S REPORT – Ian Brown

Mr. Brown gave the following report:

For the month of June 2019, the overall license activity case load was 1741, up from 1693 in May of 2019, and up from 1174 in June of 2018.

There were 676 cases currently in Legal to be reviewed, 602 cases awaiting PC Panel/ Initial Review Completed, 7 cases set for probable cause, 80 cases where probable cause had been found/administrative complaints filed, 0 settlement stipulation approved, 10 informal hearings requested,

0 cases were awaiting outside action, 40 cases ready for default, 142 formal hearings requested, 0 cases referred to DOAH, 6 cases in settlement negotiations, 0 case pending board date, 90 cases set for board presentation, 64 cases awaiting final orders, 0 cases under appeal and 0 cases had been reopened.

For the month of May 2019, 173 cases were closed.

Mr. Brown also recognized Investigator Lemery, who was present in the audience and Ms. Sally Raines from the Office of General Counsel for their continuous hard work and dedication.
