RULES/PUBLIC/LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE AGENDA – McCullers

After a brief discussion regarding the proposed changes by adding the phrase “Concrete Work” to the phrase “Precast Specialty” to rule 61G4-16.001, F.A.C., the Committee voted to approve same.

The Committee voted that there would be no adverse impact on small businesses or small counties; that it will not be likely to directly or indirectly increase regulatory costs to any entity (including government) in excess of \$200,000 in the aggregate in Florida within 1 year after implementation; and that no part of the rule should be designated a minor violation. Further, the Committee determined that this rule is mandated by statute and therefore no “sunset” provision would be included.

The Committee also addressed a public comment received on rule 61G4-16.001 and determined that no official action was needed on same.

The Committee also directed Board Counsel regarding creating proposed changes to Chapter 15 as discussed in prior Committee meetings. Board Counsel was directed to draft proposals for changes to chapter 15 for discussion at future committee meetings.

Finally, the Committee voted against researching the possibility of adding a photovoltaic specialty license.

OLD BUSINESS

Mr. McCullers proposed writing a letter regarding Mr. Lawson's two years of unexcused absences from meetings. Board members discussed sending a letter as a board to the Secretary or the Governor. Mr. Feaster reminded everyone about the removal of Board materials from laptops.

NEW BUSINESS

Florida Swimming Pool Association representative Dallas Tyson spoke to the board regarding the two different Business & Finance exams required for different types of pool licenses. The Pool Servicing exam is abbreviated, so if a contractor wants to get a different type of credential, they must take the full Business & Finance exam first. Mr. Cesarone proposed getting rid of the shortened version of the test and making the full exam applicable to all licenses. Board members voted to open the rule for further discussion - **approved**
