GENERAL SESSION

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Boyette, at 8:31am. Mr. Cawthon gave the Invocation. Mr. Maphis led the Pledge of Allegiance.

REVIEW OF MINUTES

The board reviewed the meeting minutes of the June 2020 and July 2020 board meetings, and motions were unanimously passed to approve the minutes as submitted.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT- Daniel Biggins

With nothing further to report the Board voted unanimously to approve this report.

CHAIRMAN'S REPORT- Aaron Boyette

Mr. Boyette had nothing to report.

PROSECUTING ATTORNEY'S REPORT- Ian Brown

Mr. Brown discussed about working remotely. Mr. Brown discussed Ms. Breeden for SR. Attorney.

BOOTH, JOSHUA – INFORMAL HEARING

Mr. Boudreaux was present.

Mr. Milne presented this case stating Mr. Boudreaux's application for a Certified Roofing Contractor's license was denied at the May 2020 meeting of the Board for failure to demonstrate the required experience, pursuant to section 489.111, Florida Statutes, and Rule 61G4-15.001,

Florida Administrative Code. The Notice of Intent to Deny was filed in June of 2020. Mr. Boudreaux timely requested an informal hearing.

After discussion, the Board voted to uphold the previous denial.

DENMARK, REGINALD- INFORMAL HEARING

Mr. Milne presented this case stating Mr. Denmark's application for a Certified Roofing Contractor's license was approved with conditions at the June 2020 meeting of the Board, requiring the applicant to provide proof of W2 employment to validate his experience for the license. The Notice of Intent to Approve with Conditions was filed in July of 2020. Mr. Denmark timely requested an informal hearing.

After discussion, the Board voted to uphold the previous contingencies placed on the approval.

GAITOR, ANTHONY- INFORMAL HEARING

Mr. Gaitor was present.

Mr. Milne presented this case stating Mr. Gaitor's application for a Certified Roofing Contractor's license was denied at the June 2020 meeting of the Board for failure to demonstrate the required experience, pursuant to section 489.111, Florida Statutes, and Rule 61G4-15.001, Florida Administrative Code. The Notice of Intent to Deny was filed in July of 2020. Mr. Gaitor timely requested an informal hearing.

After discussion, the Board voted to uphold the previous denial.

HOLLIBAUGH, STEVEN- INFORMAL HEARING

Mr. Milne presented this case stating Mr. Lexvold's application for a Certified Residential Contractor's license was denied at the April 2020 meeting of the Board for failure to demonstrate the required experience, pursuant to section 489.111, Florida Statutes, and Rule 61G4-15.001, Florida Administrative Code. The Notice of Intent to Deny was filed in April of 2020. Mr. Lexvold timely requested an informal hearing.

After discussion, the Board voted to uphold the previous denial.

LOUNSBERY, JAMES- MOTION TO RECONSIDER

Mr. Lounsbery was present with counsel.

Mr. Milne presented this case stating Mr. Lounsbery's application for a Certified Underground Utility and Excavation Contractor's license was denied at the January 2019 meeting of the Board for failure to demonstrate the required experience, pursuant to section 489.111, Florida Statutes, and Rule 61G4-15.001, Florida Administrative Code. The Notice of Intent to Deny was filed in February 2019. Mr. Lounsbery requested a formal hearing in front of an Administrative Law Judge but requested to appear in front of the Board on a Motion to Reconsider before pursuing the formal hearing.

After discussion, the Board voted to vacate the previous denial and to approve the application.

MANNING, WILLIAM E- RECONSIDERATION OF FINAL ORDER

Mr. Manning was present with counsel.

Mr. Milne presented this case stating that the Board entered a disciplinary order against Mr. Manning in November of 2018, imposing fines, costs, completion of additional continuing education, and placing Mr. Manning's license on probation for ten years. Mr. Milne stated that the final order for this case was filed in November of 2018. In July of 2020 Mr. Manning filed a Petition for Termination or Modification of Probation.

After consideration of the petition and discussion, the Board voted to reduce probation to four years totaling eight satisfactory appearances.

ROBERTS, DONALD- INFORMAL HEARING

Mr. Milne presented this case stating Mr. Robert's application for a Certified General Contractor's license was denied at the June 2020 meeting of the Board for failure to demonstrate the required experience, pursuant to section 489.111, Florida Statutes, and Rule 61G4-15.001, Florida Administrative Code. The Notice of Intent to Deny was filed in July of 2020. Mr. Roberts timely requested an informal hearing.

After discussion, the Board voted to vacate the previous denial and to allow the applicant to withdraw his application, contingent on the applicant providing a signed statement confirming his request to withdraw.

After discussion, the Board voted to deny the petition.

Mr. Milne presented this case stating Mr. Struther's application to qualify Flagstone Builders, Inc. as an additional business was denied at the June 2020 meeting of the Board for failure to appear as required by Rule 61G4-15.0021, Florida Administrative Code, and for failure to demonstrate he would properly supervise the construction work and business activities of the organization, pursuant to section 489.119, Florida Statutes. The Notice of Intent to Deny was filed in July of 2020. Mr. Struthers timely requested an informal hearing.

After discussion, the Board voted to uphold the denial.

TEX TENN, LLC- PETITION FOR DECLARATORY STATEMENT

A representative from Tex Tenn, LLC was not present.

Mr. Milne presented this case stating that Mr. Ryan filed a petition for a Declaratory Statement on July 27, 2020. The petition was noticed in the Florida Administrative Register on August 5, 2020. Mr. Milne noted the petitioner seeks clarification from the Board regarding the State of Florida requirements for the inspection and evaluation services of field erected, industrial cooling towers, as it pertains to statute.

After discussion, the Board voted to deny the petition.
