Children's Birthday Parties	Petitioner asked the Board if the defintion of Cosmetology in Section 477.013, F.S., includes hair-arranging and makeup application by employees of an establishment providing children's birthday parties. Fashion Photography / Cosmetic Makeovers	Petitioner asked the Board if an establishment or it's employees who provide cosmetic makeovers in connection with fashion photography are required to obtain a license under Section 477.025, F.S.
