Board Attorney Report

2023-2024 Annual Regulatory Plan

The Board approved the annual regulatory plan for 2023-2024.

Rule 61G5-29.011 – Endorsement of Specialty Registration

The Board approved the revised language and agreed that there would be no negative impact on small business nor would there likely be any increase in regulatory costs in excess of \$200,000 in the aggregate within one year after implementation. They also agreed that a violation of this rule, or any part of this rule, would not be designated as a minor violation, and that this rule should not have a sunset provision.

Rule 61G5-29.004 – Supervised Specialty Practice Exception

The Board approved the revised language and agreed that there would be no negative impact on small business nor would there likely be any increase in regulatory costs in excess of \$200,000 in the aggregate within one year after implementation. They also agreed that a violation of this rule, or any part of this rule, would not be designated as a minor violation, and that this rule should not have a sunset provision.
