Major Issues/Actions

- The Board reviewed 19 employee leasing company and controlling person applications, 18 were approved and one was tabled as additional information was needed.
- The board reviewed requests for 6 controlling person terminations, 2 name changes, 1 change of ownership and 6 terminations of employee leasing operations. One request for termination was pulled from consideration by the owner and all others were approved.
- The Board imposed discipline in the form of settlement stipulations in 11 cases presented by the general counsel's office.
- Board counsel updated the board on the Joint Administrative Procedures Committee's (JAPC) opinion concerning the workers' compensation form posed by a change to Chapter 61G7-10.0014 Florida Administrative Code (FAC). The form would require all licensees to report worker's compensation coverage quarterly. Board counsel stated that the rule change is being held in abeyance by JAPC until the end of the 2007 Legislative Session.

Legislation/Rule Promulgation

Ms. Tepper informed the board that changes to Rule 61G7-10.002, F.A.C. would become effective on December 31, 2006.
