Major Issues/Actions:

- Disciplinary action was taken on 11 waiver of rights cases with final orders being issued, and nine settlement stipulations were accepted by the board.

- The board reviewed and considered applications for employee leasing company and controlling person licensure, name change, change of ownership and controlling person relinquishment.

Legislation/Rule Promulgation

- The proposed rule change to Rule 61G7-10.0014, FAC., was discussed that would have required employee leasing companies to provide a client company workers compensation for leased employees in the event the client company did not maintain it. The Joint Administrative Procedures Committee (JAPC) had questions concerning the posed rule change, and the board asked the board counsel to draft a letter asking for clarification of their concerns. The board and the industry wants to continue to pursue this rule change.
