**Major Issues/Actions:**

- The board reviewed and considered two controlling persons applications, three changes of ownership applications, one termination of employee leasing operations application, all of which were approved. There were also six controlling person relinquishment applications reviewed; two were approved, three were denied because of open complaints, and one was tabled until the July meeting.
- Consumer member Gayla Parks and employee leasing industry members Marjorie Seltzer and Deborah Segal, were introduced to the board; this marked the three new gubernatorial appointees' first board meeting.
- The Florida Association of Professional Employer Organizations (FAPEO) announced that they have met with the Joint Administrative Procedures Committee (JAPC) and have given them their input on the proposed rule change to Rule 61G17-10.0014, FAC. This rule change involves workers compensation coverage and who is, or should be responsible for, coverage of leased employees. The board's attorney notified the board that JAPC is still evaluating the proposed rule change.
