License required	Petition presented two questions: Whether a mold assessor or mold remediator license is required in order for his business to sanitize residential and commercial environments with a specific antimicrobial product in order to kill microorganisms and inhibit their growth; and, if no license is required, whether the business is required to obtain an occupational license through its local city or council	Based on the petition's description of the tasks Petitioner's business will undertake, the Department finds that no mold remediator license is required so long as the activities or techniques described in the Petition are not applied on "mold or mold-contaminated matter of greater than 10 square feet that was not purposely grown at that location." However, a license would be required if the activities or techniques described in the Petition are applied on "mold or mold-contaminated matter of greater than 10 square feet that was not purposely grown at that location." As to Petitioner's second question, the Department does not have jurisdiction over a city or county ordinances or to issue a declaratory statement regarding those ordinances.	2014-149	Doug Linder	3/2/2015
