Each amateur shall, prior to the event, be examined by a physician licensed as an M.D. or D.O. The physician shall certify in writing the amateur's physical condition and a professional assessment as to whether or not the amateur may engage in the match. No amateur shall be permitted to engage in a match unless examined and pronounced fit to do so by a physician.	x		
All amateurs with cuts and abrasions that require dressing, bandages, or band-aids must be approved to compete by a ringside physician prior to being cleared to participate.	x		
An ambulance on site, with two paramedics or one paramedic and one Emergency Medical Technician (EMT), with at least one paramedic stationed ringside while the competition is occurring. If an athlete needs to be transported via ambulance to the hospital, another unit must arrive before the competition can continue.	x

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS			
Health and accidental death benefit policy for athletes of \$10,000 minimum. Any deductible associated with the insurance policy shall not exceed \$500. General liability insurance policy naming sanctioning body as co-insured of \$1 million per claim/\$2 million aggregate minimum. Claim forms with the promoter information and policy numbers already written on them shall be provided to the ringside physician prior to the start of the event. ASOs are required to ensure that insurance is valid through the duration of the match. ASOs shall provide proof of insurance to commission representatives if requested. ASO representative or commission representative shall prevent any match from beginning if ASO does not possess proof of insurance at start of event.	x		
RING REQUIREMENTS			
The fenced area shall not be less than 18 feet wide nor more than 32 feet wide inside the ropes.	x		
The ring floor or apron shall extend beyond the ropes not less than 18 inches.	x		
The ring platform shall not be more than 4 feet above the surrounding floor and shall be provided with steps for use of the amateur in each amateur's corner. Steps shall also be provided in a neutral corner for use by the announcer, referee, round card carrier and physicians.	x		
The ring shall be formed of four posts and at least four ropes for boxing. The ropes shall extend in parallel lines 18, 30, 42, and 54 inches in height above the ring floor.	x

1. Application Instructions (by section)

a. Section I- Application Type

- i. Check only one of the application types. Select only one sport. If your entity wishes to apply for licensure as an amateur sanctioning organization for more than one sport, you will need to submit a separate application for each sport.

b. Section II- Business Information

- i. Fill out each section completely.
- ii. In the Full Legal Name section provide your full legal name. Do not use any nicknames or initials. Please list any aliases or prior names in the prior name information section.
- iii. Provide your mailing address. This will be used for sending correspondence regarding your application and license.
- iv. Contact information is often used to quickly resolve questions with applications by telephone call or email. If contact information is not provided, questions regarding applications will be mailed to the applicant's mailing address and may take longer to resolve.
- v. Applicants are required to provide at least one physical address – i.e., not a P.O. Box. If the mailing address is not also your physical address, please provide a physical address.
- vi. Applicant's addresses are used only for Department purposes and will not be printed on the license.
- vii. Additional contact information is optional and will be used when the applicant cannot be reached using their primary contact information.
- viii. Sole proprietorship/individual ownership may not be required to obtain a Federal Employer ID Number.

e. Section V- Licensure of Officers/Representatives

- i. Applicants must provide information on any business or professional licenses or registrations held by the organization's trustees, partners, officers, directors, and owners in which the applicant has a financial interest.

f. Section VI- Prior Name

- i. Applicants must provide information on any prior names or aliases used by applicant. If the name on supporting documentation does not match the applicant's legal name, the alias used in the supporting documentation must be provided in this section. Failure to do so will result in a deficient application.

g. Section VII- Qualifications

- i. Pursuant to Section 548.0065(2), F.S., the Commission must review the applicant organization's standards to ensure that the applicant can adequately demonstrate that the principles of the organization have sufficient background, training, and experience in sanctioning and supervising matches for which the organization is approved to protect the health and safety of the amateurs participating in the matches and the public. These standards shall not contradict Chapters 61K1-3 and 61K1-4, Florida Administrative Code. If the Commission approves the applicant organization for licensure, the organization shall adhere to the requirements of Rule 61K1-3 and 61K1-4, Florida Administrative Code. These Standards are used by the Commission at the time of application to determine whether the organization's officers are qualified to operate an amateur sanctioning organization in the particular sport, and are not, *in any way*, considered a replacement for the Statutes or Rules as adopted by the legislature or Florida Athletic Commission.
- ii. Applicants must answer the listed questions in reference to their submitted standards. If the answer to the question is "Yes", the applicant must list the page number in which the Commission can locate the topic referenced in the question.
- iii. Applicants must agree to adopt and enforce all of the health and safety standards established and adopted by the Commission.
- iv. Applicants must indicate whether any trustee, partner, director, or owner for the applicant organization has ever held office or been a representative of an amateur sanctioning organization whose license in Florida or any other jurisdiction has been revoked, suspended, fined, placed on probation, or otherwise acted against. Applicants must supply identifying information on the previous organization, the position held by the officer or representative of the applicant organization, and the position held by the officer or representative in the disciplined organization.

h. Section VIII (a), (b), and (c)- Background Questions

- i. Applicants must submit answers to each of the background questions.
- ii. Question 1:

i. Section VI- Affirmation by Written Declaration

Compliance Standards for Amateur Boxing Sanctioning Organization in Florida

Compliance Documentation: Qualifications under Florida Administrative Code 61K1-4.001 & Florida Statutes Chapter 548

Introduction

This compliance document establishes and details the standards, policies, and supporting documentation required by a sanctioning organization to fully comply with Section VII of Florida Administrative Code 61K1-4, in concert with Chapter 548. Each section below is structured to address specific regulatory requirements.

Safety and Welfare

- All participants must prioritize the health and safety of athletes.
- *Athletes shall undergo pre-bout medical examinations and be cleared fit to compete by a licensed physician as required under 61K1-4.008.*
- Ringside physicians have full authority to stop bouts where necessary for athlete protection.
- Mandatory rest and suspension periods after knockouts or technical knockouts will be strictly enforced under 61K1-4.017.
- No participant may knowingly place an athlete at risk of injury by encouraging unsafe practices.
- Florida Statutes Chapter 548 (Pugilistic Exhibitions) gives the State Boxing Commission authority over amateur boxing, kickboxing, and MMA.
-
- An amateur match must be sanctioned and supervised by an amateur sanctioning organization approved by the Commission.
- Before any match, each amateur must have a pre-match physical exam by an M.D. or D.O., with _ The exam must check things like vision, heart, lungs, blood pressure, skin conditions, etc.

- Ophthalmological exam requirements; if there was prior retinopathy or detached retina, documentation from a specialist is needed.

Standard: Exclusion of Professional Boxers from Amateur Competition

Policy Statement

No professional boxer shall be permitted to participate in an amateur boxing competition sanctioned under Chapter 548, Florida Statutes, and Florida Administrative Code 61K1-4. This rule protects the integrity of amateur competition and ensures fair and safe participation for all amateur athletes.

Legal References

- Florida Statutes § 548.002(19) defines a professional as “a person who competes for any money prize or monetary gain.”
 - Florida Administrative Code Rule 61K1-4.005 explicitly excludes professionals from competing in amateur events.
-

Standard Requirements

1. Eligibility Screening
 - All athletes must provide proof of amateur status at registration.
 - Athletes must disclose any history of professional bouts, contracts, or compensation.
2. Certification by Sanctioning Body
 - The sanctioning organization shall certify that all competitors are amateurs, as defined by statute and rule.
3. Verification by Commission
 - The Florida State Boxing Commission reserves the right to review records, licenses, and competition history to verify amateur

Standard: Pre-Match Physical Examination

Every amateur boxer must undergo a pre-match physical examination conducted by a licensed physician (M.D. or D.O.) on the day of competition and prior to entering the ring. This examination ensures that only medically fit participants are permitted to compete, in compliance with Rule 61K1-4.008, Florida Administrative Code.

Legal Reference

- Rule 61K1-4.008, F.A.C. – Pre-Match Physical Examination Requirement

Standard Requirements

Mandatory Examination

- A licensed physician must examine each competitor on the day of the bout.
- The exam must cover:
 - Heart and lung function
 - Vision and pupil reaction
 - Blood pressure
 - Skin conditions (including contagious diseases)
 - Any injuries that may impair safe competition
 -

1. Medical Clearance

- Only athletes who receive a written “fit to compete” clearance from the physician may participate.
- Clearance must be signed and dated by the physician and kept in the event medical file.

2. Exclusion Criteria


- Athletes showing symptoms of illness, injury, or condition that endangers safety shall not be allowed to compete.
- Physicians may use discretion to require additional testing or decline participation.

3. Documentation

- Records of pre-match examinations must be maintained for Commission inspection.
- Forms shall include the athlete’s name, date, physician’s signature, and outcome (“Cleared” or “Not Cleared”).

Citation for Compliance Forms

- Rule 61K1-4.008, F.A.C. – Pre-Match Physical Examination

 In short: This standard requires every competitor to be medically cleared by a physician before competing, consistent with Florida law. For forms asking “page number,” you should enter 61K1-4.008.

Standard: Exclusion of Medically Unfit Participant

No athlete deemed medically unfit shall be permitted to compete in any amateur boxing event sanctioned under Chapter 548, Florida Statutes, and Rule 61K1-4 of the Florida Administrative Code. Protecting athlete health and safety is the overriding priority of this organization.

Legal References

Standard: Ringside Medical Equipment and Personnel

Policy Statement

At every sanctioned amateur boxing event, qualified medical personnel and appropriate emergency medical equipment shall be present at ringside during each match. This standard is mandated by Rule 61K1-4.006, F.A.C. to ensure immediate medical care for athletes in the event of injury.

Legal Reference

- Rule 61K1-4.006, F.A.C. – Medical Safety and Care of Participants

Standard Requirements

1. Ringside Physician
 - A licensed physician (M.D. or D.O.) must be present at ringside for the entire duration of each bout.
 - The physician shall have the authority to stop any contest in the interest of a boxer's health.
2. Emergency Medical Personnel
 - At least one qualified emergency medical technician (EMT) or paramedic must be onsite.
 - Personnel must remain ringside, not stationed elsewhere in the venue, for rapid response.

3. Required Equipment

The following equipment must be immediately available at ringside:

- Emergency oxygen and administration equipment
- Stretcher and immobilization devices (neck brace, spine board)
- Suction apparatus
- Defibrillator (AED)
- Standard first-aid supplies
- Communication device to contact emergency medical services (EMS)

4. Ambulance Access


- A properly equipped ambulance must be available at the venue, with a clear and immediate path for evacuation to the nearest hospital.

5. Enforcement

- No amateur boxing event may begin until ringside medical personnel and equipment are confirmed in place.
- Inspectors must verify compliance before the start of competition.
- Failure to comply will result in cancellation or suspension of the event.

Citation for Compliance Forms

- Rule 61K1-4.006, F.A.C. – Medical Safety and Care of Participants

 In short: Every event must have a ringside physician, emergency personnel, and full medical equipment present and ready, as set forth in 61K1-4.006, F.A.C.

- § 548.046, F.S. – Prohibition against competition by medically unfit participants

Standard Requirements

1. Mandatory Physician Clearance

- All athletes must undergo a pre-bout medical exam by a licensed physician (M.D. or D.O.) on the day of competition.
- Athletes must receive a written “Fit to Compete” clearance to participate.

2. Automatic Disqualification for Medical Concerns

- Athletes who show signs of illness, injury, or any condition that may endanger themselves or others shall not be allowed to compete.

1. Restrictions on Types of Blows

Policy Statement

The sanctioning organization strictly prohibits the use of illegal blows pursuant to Rule 61K1-4.-017. All matches sanctioned under the organization's jurisdiction must conform to enumerated forbidden techniques, including but not limited to strikes to the back of the head, spine, groin, or other sensitive areas. These standards are codified in the organization's Rulebook (see Organizational Rulebook, p. 15-17).

Explanation and Reference

Under Florida Statutes, Chapter 548.006(3), "Blows to the back of the head, neck, or other specifically prohibited areas are strictly forbidden." The Administrative Code further elaborates on specific prohibited actions, such as strikes to the spine or kidney area, and prohibits techniques such as head butting, biting, hair pulling, and groin attacks¹. Sanctioning organizations must ensure their own competitive rulebook mirrors or exceeds these minimum prohibitions, and that all contestants and officials are informed and trained on these restrictions.

Enforcement procedures must also be part of the internal event protocol, as further explained in Attachment A: Sample Rulebook (see p. 15-17). Ringside officials are responsible for monitoring compliance, and any infraction must be immediately reported to the Florida Athletic Commission.

2. Limits on Time and Frequency of Matches

Policy Statement

The sanctioning organization will enforce the match time frequency requirements of Rule 61K1- 4.017 F.A.C.

3. Mandated Insurance for Medical Care

Policy Statement

The sanctioning organization will enforce the mandated insurance for medical care requirements of Rule 61K1- 4.007 F.A.C.

4. Identification of the Sanctioning Body in Promotional Materials

Policy Statement

The sanctioning organization requires that its name and/or logo be clearly displayed on all event promotional materials, including posters, digital advertisements, press releases, and tickets, thereby ensuring transparency and regulatory clarity.

5. Cooperation with State Regulators and the Florida Athletic Commission

Under Florida law, sanctioning organizations bear a number of obligations regarding cooperation, reporting, and access as part of their qualifying standards. The following subsections outline and provide sample policy language for each operational requirement.

5.1. Advance Notification to the Commission

Policy Statement:

“The sanctioning organization will provide written notice to the Florida Athletic Commission not less than 30 days prior to each sanctioned event, specifying date, location, list of participants, officials, match times, and any special circumstances. Notice will be transmitted by both email and certified mail, and a receipt thereof will be retained in organizational files.”⁵

5.2. Free Admission for Commission Officials

Policy Statement:

“The organization and its promoters shall admit Florida Athletic Commission officials, staff, and inspectors to all sanctioned events at no charge, including access to restricted and backstage areas necessary for the performance of official duties. A minimum of two tickets shall be held in reserve for the Commission, identified as 'Official Admission.’”²

5.3. Self-Reporting of Violations

Policy Statement:

“The sanctioning organization and its agents must report any known or suspected violations of Chapter 548, F.S., or applicable rules and organizational policies to the Commission immediately upon discovery. This includes but is not limited to: unauthorized events, medical emergencies, or unapproved modifications to competition rules.”⁵⁶

5.4. Appearance Before the Commission

Policy Statement:

“Upon request, the organization, or any of its officers, must appear before the Florida Athletic Commission to provide clarifications, answer questions relating to an event, or respond to disciplinary matters. Failure to appear, without just cause, shall constitute grounds for organizational sanctioning review.”⁵

5.5. Cooperation with Commission Requests

Policy Statement:

“The organization pledges full cooperation with all information requests, documentation submissions, and investigatory procedures initiated by the Florida Athletic Commission or its designated staff. Requested materials shall be provided within the timeline designated by the Commission and maintained in a readily retrievable format.”⁵

Policy Statement:

“All officers, members, participants, and affiliates of the sanctioning organization are strictly prohibited from engaging in, encouraging, or condoning any form of aggressive, intimidating, retaliatory, or disrespectful conduct toward the Florida

Athletic Commission’s officials or staff, whether verbal, physical, or electronic. Violations result in immediate disciplinary action and referral to the Commission.”⁷

These templates and forms are subject to routine update and may be tailored to each event or regulatory revision.

Bylaws set forth governance structure, officer duties, election protocols, membership standards, and disciplinary procedures in accordance with both Chapter 548 and best practices for nonprofit sports organizations. They expressly incorporate policy statements addressing all Commission cooperation, event notification, reporting, and internal control standards referenced above.

Section 1 — Purpose and Authority

This manual sets forth the standards adopted by [Florida Amateur Boxing Confederation] to comply with §548.0065(2), Florida Statutes, which requires amateur sanctioning organizations to establish, publish, and enforce rules and standards designed to ensure the safety, integrity, and fairness of amateur boxing competition in Florida.

Section 2 — Safety and Welfare of Participants

1. 2. 3. Every sanctioned event shall provide:

○ Pre-bout and post-bout medical examinations (Rule 61K1-4.008, F.A.C.) and Rule 61K1-4.009.

○ Ringside physicians, emergency medical personnel, and equipment (Rule 61K1-4.006, F.A.C.) and 61K1-4.004.

○ Protective gear requirements (headgear, groin protectors, mouthpieces, and gloves by weight class).Mandatory rest periods after knockouts or technical stoppages.

Section 3 — Insurance Coverage

1. 2. All sanctioned events must provide accident and medical insurance covering necessary medical care for injuries sustained during competition. Proof of coverage must be presented to the Commission or its representative before the start of any event.

Section 4 — Integrity of Competition

1. 2. 3. Professionals, as defined by §548.002 (19)), F.S., are excluded from all amateur events (Rule 61K1-4.017, F.A.C.). Athlete eligibility verification must be documented prior to participation. Matchmaking shall be conducted fairly, with attention to safety, skill, and weight classifications.

Section 5 — Medical Personnel and Equipment

1. 2. 3. 4. A licensed physician must be stationed at ringside during all bouts with authority to stop contests. EMT or paramedic personnel must remain on-site throughout the event. Emergency medical equipment including oxygen, AED, and stretcher must be immediately available. Ambulance access and evacuation route must be ensured.

Section 6 — Cooperation with the Commission

1. 2. 3. The organization shall notify the Florida State Boxing Commission of all scheduled events in advance. Commission representatives, inspectors, and employees shall be granted free access to venues, weigh-ins, dressing rooms, and all event areas.

Section 7 — Code of Conduct

1. 2. 3. All athletes, coaches, officials, and representatives shall:

- Exhibit professionalism, sportsmanship, and respect.
- Refrain from abusive, threatening, or discriminatory conduct.

Retaliation against whistleblowers, inspectors, or participants is prohibited.

Violations will result in disciplinary action, including suspension or disqualification.

Section 8 — Recordkeeping and Reporting

1. The organization shall maintain:

- Athlete registration and eligibility files.

- Medical examination and clearance records.
- Bout results, suspensions, and disciplinary actions.
 - 2. The organization shall self-report violations of these standards or Florida law to the Commission promptly.

Section 9 — Training and Certification

1. 2. All referees, judges, and timekeepers must be trained and, if required, licensed by the Commission. Continuing education and periodic evaluations will be provided to ensure compliance with evolving standards.

Section 10 — Enforcement and Discipline

1. 2. Failure to comply with these standards may result in suspension or revocation of sanctioning authority. The organization commits to fully cooperating with any Commission investigation or disciplinary action.

Adoption Clause

These standards are adopted by [Florida amateur Boxing confederation] in compliance with §548.0065(2), Florida Statutes, and are binding on all athletes, coaches, officials, and representatives associated with sanctioned amateur boxing events.

This Appendix is adopted and incorporated into the organizational rules to ensure strict compliance with Chapter 548, Florida Statutes, and Rule 61K1-4 of the Florida Administrative Code. It establishes uniform standards for weight classifications, medical and safety precautions, and professional conduct. These provisions are intended to safeguard the health and welfare of amateur boxing participants, promote fairness and integrity in competition, and uphold the authority of the Florida State Boxing Commission and its designated representatives. All participants, coaches, officials, and sanctioning body representatives are required to adhere to the standards set forth herein as a condition of participation in any sanctioned event held within the State of Florida.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

2.1 **Pre-Bout Medical Examination** – All contestants must be examined and medically cleared by a licensed physician prior to participation (Rule 61K1-4.008, F.A.C.).

2.2 **Ringside Medical Coverage** – A licensed physician shall remain ringside for the duration of all contests, with qualified emergency medical personnel present (Rule 61K1-4.006, F.A.C.).

2.3 **Medical Equipment** – Each event shall maintain, at minimum: oxygen unit with masks, stretcher with immobilization equipment, and an Automated External Defibrillator (AED).

2.4 **Protective Equipment** – Contestants shall utilize USA Boxing–approved gloves, headgear (when applicable), groin protection, mouthpieces, and female chest protection.

2.5 **Prohibited Blows** – Contestants shall not strike the back of the head, kidneys, or below the belt, nor use the elbow, shoulder, or head in an intentional manner (Rule 61K1-4.017 F.A.C.).

2.6 **Post-Bout Evaluation** – Any contestant who suffers a knockout or is deemed medically unfit shall be referred immediately for evaluation, with suspensions imposed as determined by the ringside physician (Rule 61K1-4.009, F.A.C.).

2. CODE OF CONDUCT

3.1 **Respectful Conduct** – All persons shall conduct themselves in a professional manner, refraining from aggressive, threatening, discriminatory, or demeaning behavior.

3.2 **Compliance with Commission Authority** – All persons shall comply with lawful directives of referees, inspectors, and the Official in Charge. Commission representatives shall be admitted without charge to any sanctioned event or portion thereof.

3.3 Honesty & Fairness – Records, bout sheets, and matchmaking shall be accurate and free of manipulation. No falsification of documents or concealment of information is permitted.

3.4 Harassment Prohibited – Harassment or discrimination based on race, creed, color, gender, or national origin is strictly forbidden.

3.5 Self-Reporting Obligation – Any violation of safety standards, Code of Conduct, or organizational rules must be reported promptly to the Commission by the sanctioning body or its agents.

3.6 Sanctions – Violations of this Code of Conduct may result in suspension, forfeiture of sanctioning rights, removal from events, or other penalties as provided under Chapter 548, F.S., and applicable rules of the Florida Administrative Code.

SETTLEMENT STIPULATION

Petitioner, Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation (DBPR), by and through undersigned counsel, and Peter J. Fernandez d/b/a Starfight Productions, LLC, (Respondent) hereby stipulate and agree that the Florida Athletic Commission (Commission) issue a Final Order adopting and incorporating the provisions of this Stipulation as final agency action in this cause.

STIPULATED FACTS AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. At all times material herein, Respondent was licensed as a participant in the State of Florida, having been issued license number MTCH 437.
2. Respondent admits being subject to the provisions of Chapter 548, Florida Statutes, the rules promulgated thereto and, therefore, the jurisdiction of DBPR and the Commission.
3. Respondent admits that DBPR served Respondent with the Administrative Complaint, charging the Respondent with violation(s) of certain provisions of Chapter 548, Florida Statutes, and/or the rules promulgated thereto. A true and correct copy of the Administrative Complaint is

attached hereto and incorporated by reference as Exhibit "A."

4. Respondent neither admits nor denies the allegations of fact contained in the Administrative Complaint attached hereto as Exhibit "A."
5. Respondent admits that the facts set forth in the Administrative Complaint, if proven, constitute violations of Chapter 548, Florida Statutes, as alleged in the Administrative Complaint attached hereto as Exhibit "A."
6. Respondent understands DBPR and the Commission's acceptance of this Stipulation constitutes disciplinary action within the meaning of Chapter 548, Florida Statutes.
7. Respondents shall not in the future violate Chapter 548, Florida Statutes, or the rules promulgated thereto.
8. This Stipulation shall become effective immediately upon filing of the Final Order (hereinafter referred to as the "Effective Date"). All dates referenced herein shall commence to run on the Effective Date.

STIPULATED DISPOSITION

9. COSTS: Respondent shall pay administrative costs, excluding attorney's fees, of **\$156.92**. Said costs shall be paid within 30 days of entry of the **Final Order by Respondent to the Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Florida Athletic Commission, 2601 Blair Stone Road, Tallahassee, Florida 32399**.
10. FINE: Respondent shall pay an administrative fine in the amount of **\$250.00**. Said fine shall be paid within 90 days of entry of the Final Order by Respondent to the **Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Florida Athletic Commission, 2601 Blair Stone Road, Tallahassee, Florida 32399**.
11. METHOD OF PAYMENT: All fines and costs made pursuant to this Stipulation shall be made


payable to the Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Florida Athletic Commission, 2601 Blair Stone Road, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-1027. Your case number(s) must be clearly referenced when making payment. **Do not send in any payments until you receive a Final Order.**

12. The parties understand that this Stipulation is subject to the approval of DBPR and of the Commission, and that in the event of its disapproval, it shall have no further force and effect.
13. Respondent has executed this Stipulation to avoid further administrative action with respect to this cause. Respondent authorizes the Commission to review and examine all DBPR investigative materials prior to or in conjunction with its consideration of this Stipulation. Further, in the event the Commission disapproves this Stipulation, Respondent agrees that examination of any documents or records related thereto shall not be deemed to have unfairly prejudiced DBPR, the Commission or any of its members, nor shall such action disqualify any of them from further participation in the resolution of this cause.
14. Respondent agrees that Petitioner may conduct further investigation at any time subsequent to the Commission's acceptance of this Stipulation. Respondent further agrees that Petitioner shall have any and all rights and authority the law provides to ensure Respondent's compliance with Chapters 455 and 548, Florida Statutes, and the rules promulgated thereto. Respondent further agrees that DBPR and the Commission may consider this Stipulation in connection with any future disciplinary proceeding.
15. The parties understand that this Stipulation and any final order adopting and incorporating its terms shall not preclude or deter DBPR or the Commission from other disciplinary proceedings against Respondent for acts or omissions unrelated to those set forth in the Administrative Complaint. Respondent hereby waives all notice requirements and right to seek judicial review

or to otherwise challenge or contest the validity or enforcement of the terms of this Stipulation and/or of any resulting final order of the Commission adopting and incorporating same.

16. All parties hereto shall bear any and all attorney's fees and costs they may have incurred in connection with this cause, except for the costs set forth above which shall be paid by Respondent.
17. Should Respondent withdraw from or in any way or manner cancel, annul, alter, repudiate, or revoke the terms of this Stipulation prior to presentation or consideration by the Commission, Respondent agrees to waive any rights to seek attorney's fees and costs Respondent may have incurred as the result of the disciplinary proceeding up to and including the date of withdrawal from the settlement Stipulation or attempt to alter, change, annul, repudiate, or revoke the terms of this Stipulation.
18. DBPR reserves the right to correct any typographical errors or make any non-material changes to this Stipulation after it is signed.

ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT

The Department of Business and Professional Regulation (“Petitioner”) files this Administrative Complaint against Peter J. Fernandez d/b/a Starfight Productions, LLC, (“Respondent or Starfight”), and alleges:

1. Petitioner is the state agency charged with regulating the practice of pugilistic exhibitions in the State of Florida pursuant to Chapters 120 and 548, Florida Statutes.
2. At all times material hereto, Respondent was licensed as a matchmaker in the State of Florida having been issued DBPR license No. MTCH 437.
3. At all times material hereto, Respondent was added to Starfight Productions, LLC, as an Authorized Person/ Manager within their Articles of Organization.
4. Starfight failed to report this change, as required, to the Florida Athletic Commission.
5. Respondent's last known address is 4519 Grainary Avenue, Tampa, Florida 33624.
6. Section 548.071(1), Florida Statutes, states “The Commission may suspend or revoke a license or permit if the Commission finds the licensee or permittee is guilty of violating

this chapter or the rules of the Commission.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests the Commission enter an order imposing one or more of the following penalties: permanent revocation or suspension of Respondent’s license, restriction of practice, imposition of an administrative fine not to exceed \$5,000 for each violation, issuance of a reprimand, placement of Respondent on probation, assessment of costs, and/or any other relief that the Commission deems appropriate.







ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT

The Department of Business and Professional Regulation (“Petitioner”) files this Administrative Complaint before the Florida Athletic Commission (“Commission”), against Isaias Nahuel Augustin Caniza (“Respondent”), and alleges:

1. Petitioner is the state agency charged with regulating the practice of pugilistic exhibitions in the State of Florida pursuant to Chapters 120 and 548, Florida Statutes.
2. At all times material to this Complaint, Respondent was licensed as a participant in the State of Florida, having been issued license numbers PART 14740 and PART 15383.
3. Respondent’s last known address is 760 N.W. 4th Street, Suite 101, Florida 33128
4. In or about March, 2025, Respondent submitted a blood sample to the Commission.
5. The blood sample was supposedly processed by Finlay Clinical Laboratory (Finlay) on May 18, 2025.
6. On or about September 26, 2025 the Commission contacted Finlay regarding the validity and authenticity of the lab results provided by Respondent.

7. On or about the same date, Finley confirmed that Respondent's name was not in their database.

8. Section 548.071(1), Florida Statutes, authorizes suspension or revocation of a license if the licensee violates Chapter 548, Florida Statutes, or the rules of the Commission.

9. Section 548.075(1), Florida Statutes, authorizes imposition of a fine for any violation of Chapter 548, in addition to any other punishment provided for such violation.

10. Section 548.071(4), Florida Statutes, states that, "[t]he commission may suspend or revoke a license or permit if the commission finds that the licensee...[i]s guilty of unprofessional or unethical conduct."

11. Rule 61K1-3.022(5), Florida Administrative Code, states that unprofessional and unethical conduct, for professional licenses, shall include, "[f]alsifying or altering records related to boxing, kickboxing and mixed martial arts."

12. Based on the foregoing, Respondent violated Section 548.071(4), Florida Statutes, through a violation of Rule 61K1-3.022(5), Florida Administrative Code, when Respondent unethically submitted a false lab report regarding his blood sample.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests the Commission enter an order imposing one or more of the following penalties: permanent revocation or suspension of Respondent's license, restriction of practice, imposition of an administrative fine not to exceed \$5,000 for each violation, issuance of a reprimand, placement of Respondent on probation, assessment of costs, and/or any other relief that the Commission deems appropriate.



ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT

The Department of Business and Professional Regulation (“Petitioner”) files this Administrative Complaint before the Florida Athletic Commission (“Commission”), against Isaias Nahuel Augustin Caniza (“Respondent”), and alleges:

1. Petitioner is the state agency charged with regulating the practice of pugilistic exhibitions in the State of Florida pursuant to Chapters 120 and 548, Florida Statutes.
2. At all times material to this Complaint, Respondent was licensed as a participant in the State of Florida, having been issued license numbers PART 14740 and PART 15383.
3. Respondent’s last known address is 760 N.W. 4th Street, Suite 101, Florida 33128
4. In or about March, 2025, Respondent submitted a blood sample to the Commission.
5. The blood sample was supposedly processed by Finlay Clinical Laboratory (Finlay) on May 18, 2025.
6. On or about September 26, 2025 the Commission contacted Finlay regarding the validity and authenticity of the lab results provided by Respondent.

7. On or about the same date, Finley confirmed that Respondent's name was not in their database.

8. Section 548.071(1), Florida Statutes, authorizes suspension or revocation of a license if the licensee violates Chapter 548, Florida Statutes, or the rules of the Commission.

9. Section 548.075(1), Florida Statutes, authorizes imposition of a fine for any violation of Chapter 548, in addition to any other punishment provided for such violation.

10. Section 548.071(4), Florida Statutes, states that, "[t]he commission may suspend or revoke a license or permit if the commission finds that the licensee...[i]s guilty of unprofessional or unethical conduct."

11. Rule 61K1-3.022(5), Florida Administrative Code, states that unprofessional and unethical conduct, for professional licenses, shall include, "[f]alsifying or altering records related to boxing, kickboxing and mixed martial arts."

12. Based on the foregoing, Respondent violated Section 548.071(4), Florida Statutes, through a violation of Rule 61K1-3.022(5), Florida Administrative Code, when Respondent unethically submitted a false lab report regarding his blood sample.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests the Commission enter an order imposing one or more of the following penalties: permanent revocation or suspension of Respondent's license, restriction of practice, imposition of an administrative fine not to exceed \$5,000 for each violation, issuance of a reprimand, placement of Respondent on probation, assessment of costs, and/or any other relief that the Commission deems appropriate.




