- The Commission agreed all marketing advertisements relating to teams including small trinkets and gifts must comply with Rule 61J2-10.026, regardless of the printer criteria.

 The Commission agreed that enforcement of any portion of the rule will not commence until July 1, 2019, including the requirement to have a written records of the teams currently in a brokerage company.

Discussion Relating to Broker Qualifications Standards

Chair Luzier continued discussion and presented plan to further research into the model of other states as it pertains to obtaining a Broker's license. States were assigned to various Commissioners.
