AUTHORIZATION FOR PARENTAL/SCHOOL 30-HOUR WAIVER

Pursuant to Chapter 450, Part I, Florida Statutes, minors 16/17 years of age may not work more than 30 hours per week. This waiver will authorize the below-named minor to be employed to **work up to 40 hours in one work week**. The minor must remain in compliance with all provisions of the Child Labor Statute, except what is specified above. The employer must maintain a copy of the waiver in the minor's employment records and produce it upon request from the department. **This does not apply to minors 14/15 years of age.**

Note: Partial waivers are not required during the winter, spring, and summer breaks when school is not in session. During the summer, minors 16 and 17 may work unlimited hours; however, if scheduled to work 8 hours or more in any one day, they may not work for more than 4 hours continuously without an interval of at least a 30-minute uninterrupted meal break.
