

## DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS AND PROFESSIONAL REGULATION LICENSEE DOWNLOAD FILES SITE DISCLAIMER

Under Chapter 119, Florida Statutes, the Department of Business and Professional Regulation (DBPR) is required to make available for inspection and copying any public record regardless of physical format, which is not otherwise exempted from public access by general law. To fulfill this obligation, the Department provides copies of electronic records to the public through this free download site.

The Department is only required to provide data in the format in which they are maintained and, as a result, does not provide paper copies of this information. In addition, the Department is not required to reformat its records to meet a requestor's particular needs.

Section 119.01(2)(b), F.S., requires only that the agency provide electronic data in some common format such as, but not limited to, the American Standard Code for Information Interchange (ASCII) text format. Therefore, the download files provided from this site are formatted as ASCII text, quote/comma delimited.

Due to this, it is important that requestors know the following information before downloading a file:

- The Department does not offer technical support during or after the download process. Please refer to your software manuals, Corporate Help Desk, or Internet Service Provider for any assistance you require;
- File size may be larger than the space available on your computer; if so free up additional space before attempting the download;
- Some features such as tabs, font selection, and graphics may be lost when converting a file to ASCII text;
- Files require Windows 3.1 and a 486 or higher computer and may not be compatible with Macintosh or Apple computer systems;
- The Department is not responsible for damages sustained to existing user data, software, and/or hardware from data obtained through the download process
- Although data are refreshed weekly, system maintenance may delay the updating of files. To determine the timeliness of data, please refer to the date posted. - When downloading large data files such as the Construction, Cosmetology, and Real Estate licensees into Excel, you may exceed the number of rows that can be loaded. This error is usually encountered when an attempt to open a file with more than 65,536 rows or 256 columns is made. Excel is limited to 65,536 rows of data and 256 columns per worksheet. You can have many worksheets with this number of rows and columns, but they are usually capable of fitting into one workbook (file). The number of worksheets you can have per workbook is limited only by the amount of available memory your system has. By default, Excel can manage 3 worksheets, more if there is available memory to support the quantity of data.

Truncation of rows or columns in excess of the limit is automatic and is not configurable. This issue can usually be remedied by opening the source file with a text editor, such as Microsoft Office Word, and then saving the file off into multiple files with row or column counts within the limits of an Excel worksheet. These files can then be opened or imported into Excel worksheets.

If you are using a data format that does not support use of a text editor, it may be easier to import the data into Microsoft Office Access and then use the export feature of Access to import the data to an Excel format. Other methods of importing large source material into multiple worksheets are available, but may be more complex than using either a text editor or Access

## FILE LAYOUTS

Listed below are the file layouts available on the download site. The file layout will explain the contents of each field. Some fields may be blank. This is usually because the licensee, applicant, or examinee did not provide the Department with that particular information. Sometimes the field is blank because it only applies to a handful of professions such is the case with the Doing Business As field. Use the fields provided to customize your list.

For example: to create a Recently Licensed List, download the licensee file for the Board that interests you. Import the file into a program that allows sorting such as a spreadsheet or database. Then sort by occupation and delete any occupations that you don't wish to retain. Then sort the remaining records by ORIGINAL LICENSE DATE. Now the names are in order by when they were first licensed. Delete any records having an original license data EARLIER than you need. You may also sort by county code field to find all the addresses in a particular county or you may sort by expiration date to see which licensees will be expiring soon.

Fields are separated by a COMMA/QUOTE ("25","Real Estate"). When importing the file into a spreadsheet, phone numbers, license numbers, and zip codes often display oddly until you lengthen the width of that field. This is not a technical problem. If you need assistance lengthening a field, consult your user manual or software HELP screen.

Please note that some fields are optional in our database. Therefore some applicant, examinee, or licensee records may contain blank fields.
